

Energy Efficiency Rebate Program for Residential HVAC

Rebate Information/Terms and Conditions

Procedure

1. Read the program terms and conditions and the guidelines provided with this package.
2. Purchase and have a licensed HVAC contractor install the equipment. A list of Energy Star approved equipment is provided on the DWP website and upon request.
3. Once installation is complete, submit a completed, signed Rebate Request form, a copy of your receipt(s) or invoice, applicable permits, installation records, and a copy of your current electric bill. Please keep a copy for your records.
4. DWP will contact you once your paperwork has been reviewed and approved.
5. DWP will send you a check for the approved rebate value or process a credit to your account. A check may take 4-6 weeks to be processed and mailed. Credits to your account will occur within a week.

Eligibility

1. The property must receive bundled electric service from the City of Corona Department of Water and Power (DWP).
2. The equipment must be purchased after January 1, 2016.
3. Rebates are based on Energy Star Rating. Equipment must meet the required efficiency levels as applicable for SEER and EER. Refer to the approved equipment list available on the DWP website or upon request.

Program Terms

1. Rebate application and required documentation must be received within 90 days of equipment installation or the customer may forfeit the rebate. Failure to provide forms and other documentation may result in the customer's ineligibility for the rebate.
2. The customer is solely responsible for obtaining all required building permits and completing inspection process required by local jurisdiction.
3. Contractor performing work must possess active C-20 license (Heating, Ventilation, & Air Conditioning — HVAC) for AC installations.
4. DWP reserves the right to inspect installation premise or request additional information/documentation prior to rebate payment.
5. Rebates are available until funding is exhausted. DWP reserves the right to modify, amend or terminate the Energy Efficiency Rebate Program in whole or in part, at any time and for any reason without prior notice.
